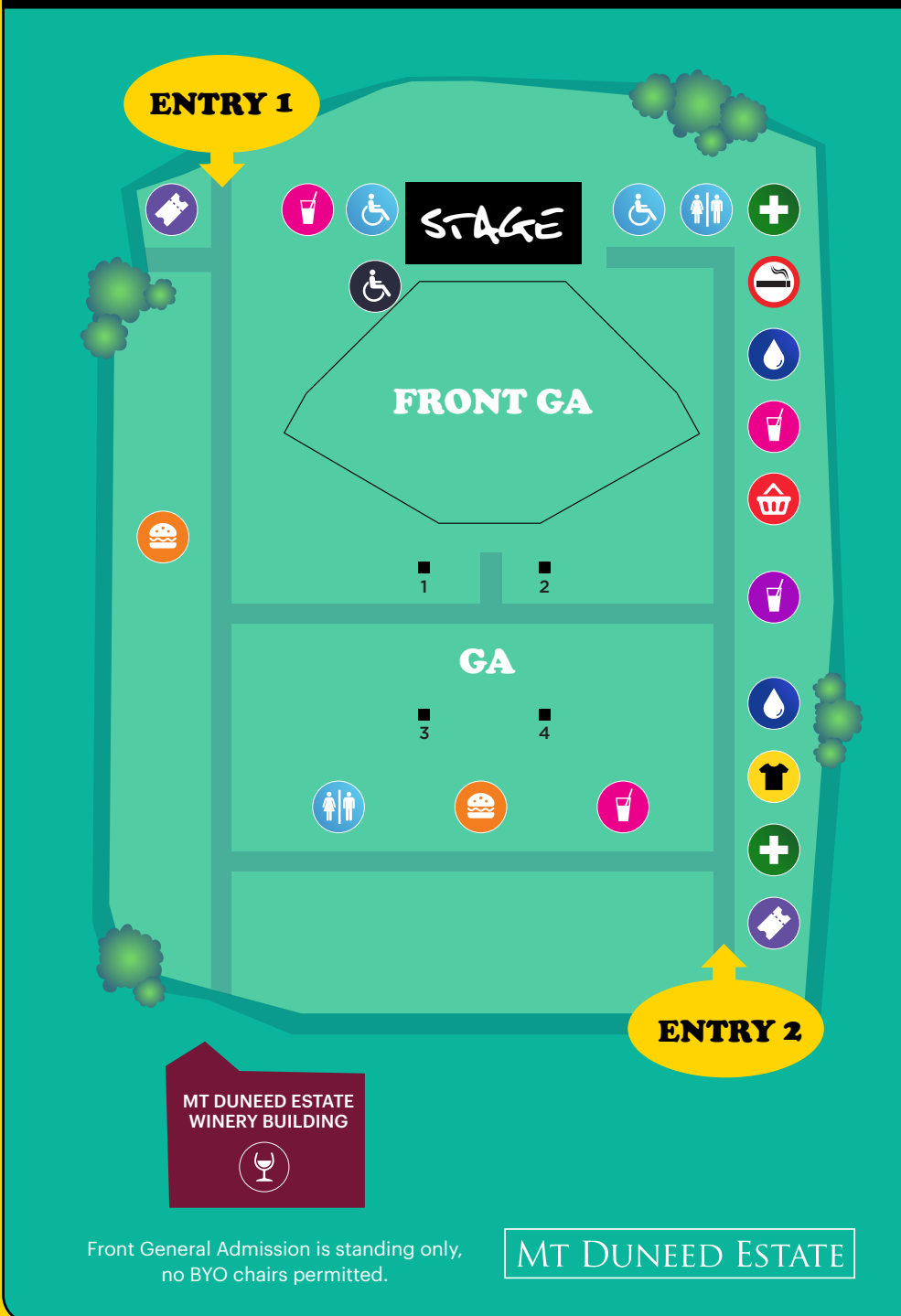

# WHAT TO BRING

**HOT TIP #2:** This is an outdoor event with uneven ground – wear sturdy dancing shoes and dress for the weather!

- This outdoor event has uneven terrain. We strongly suggest closed shoes and *do not recommend* thongs or sandals.
- Come prepared for rain or shine. Wear weather-appropriate clothing
- For sunny days bring a hat & sunglasses for protection and plenty of sunscreen with you (no aerosols).
- If rain is forecast, please bring a raincoat and suitable footwear. No umbrellas allowed.
- Keep hydrated, sealed plastic clear water bottles (Still or Sparkling) up to 1.5l in size are permitted into the event.
- Plastic reusable water bottles are allowed (no stainless steel) but must be empty at entry. Free refill stations are available on-site.
- Bars and merchandise stands will only take card payment, no cash sales.
- This is a cashless event.

- Note: there are no pass outs for the event, please bring everything you require with you upon entry as you will not be able to retrieve additional items from parked cars or come and go from the venue.
- **FRONT GA TICKET HOLDERS**  
No camping chairs, picnic rugs or hard eskies permitted in this area. Soft cooler sized bags are permitted.
- **GA LAWN TICKET HOLDERS**  
Standard sized camping chairs or picnic rugs and eskis are permitted in this area.

# WHAT NOT TO BRING

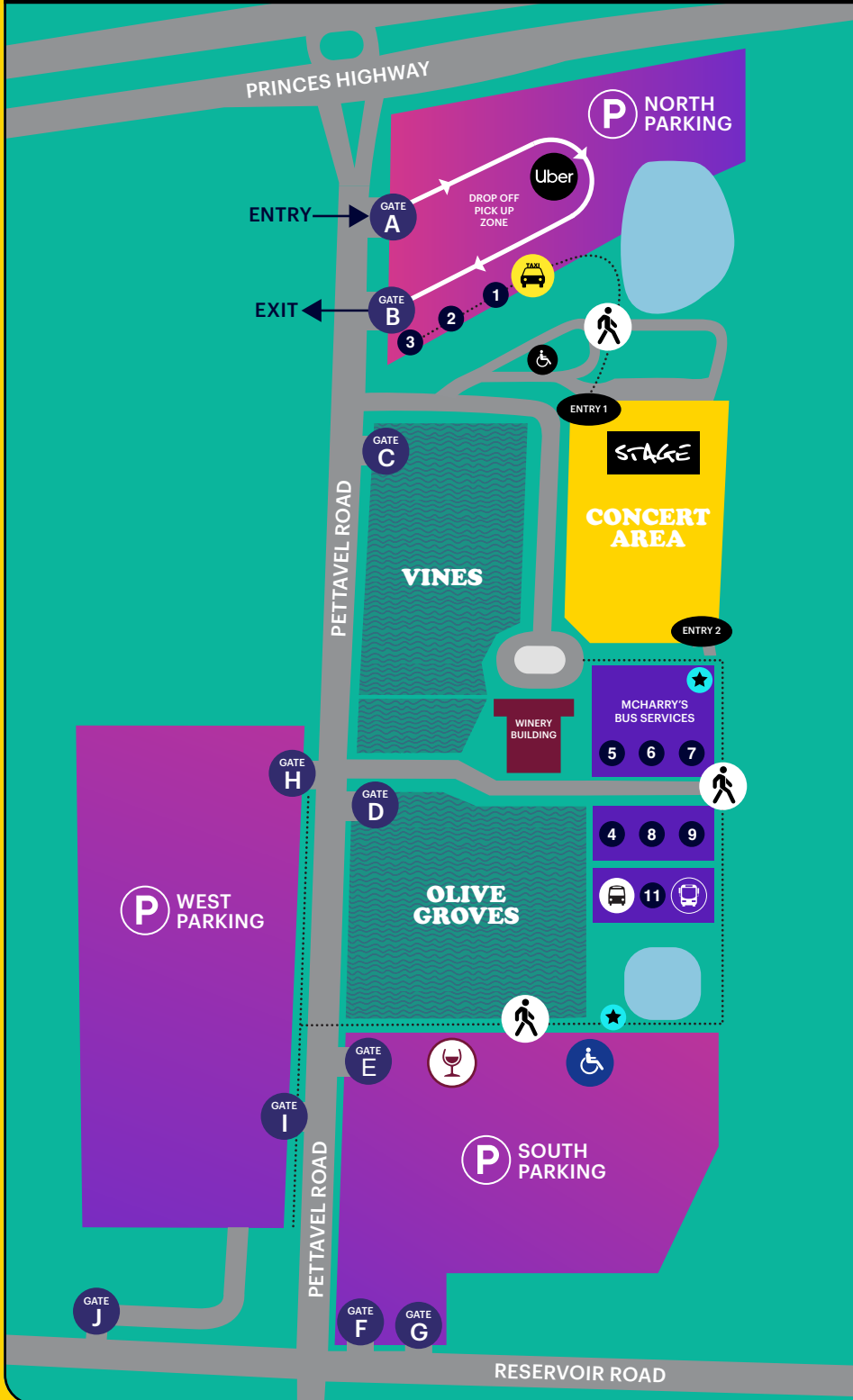
- This is a licensed event. Strictly NO BYO alcohol or non-alcoholic drinks (only exception is sealed plastic bottled water up to 1.5l – bottle must be clear)
- NO Illegal substances including controlled, dangerous or illicit drugs or drug paraphernalia
- NO Eskies over 26 litre
- NO Large backpacks
- NO Beach trolleys/carts (including collapsible carts) prams or strollers
- NO Deck or reclining chairs, bean bags, air beds, tables, tents, sunshades, parasols, umbrellas
- NO Aerosols
- NO Glass (including containers of makeup or perfume)
- NO Metal cutlery, stainless steel cups or stainless steel drink bottles
- NO Large flags/banners with handles exceeding 1.0m
- NO Fireworks, Flares, Smoke bombs, laserpointers
- NO Selfie and go pro sticks, Professional cameras, video or recording equipment, camcorders or drones.
- There will be a security check at the gate and prohibited items will be confiscated. Event organisers do not take any responsibility for confiscated items.

**HOT TIP #3:** DON'T MISS THE SHOW – Drink responsibly, Stay In Control and keep hydrated

Management reserves the right to refuse admission. If you are intoxicated on arrival, you will be refused entry to the concert and no refund provided. All patrons must adhere to local licensing laws. Intoxicated or disorderly patrons will be evicted from the venue. **No wine bottles permitted in the Front GA area after 7pm.**

# HOW TO GET THERE



From Melbourne & Geelong drive via Princess Hwy and follow event signage.

From Waurm Ponds, Anglesea Rd and the Great Ocean Rd, enter the site from Reservoir Rd.

Parking available on site and can be pre-purchased for \$30 per vehicle or you can pay on the day by cash or card. If you CAR-POOL to the concert and arrive in a vehicle with 4 or more paying ticket holders you will NOT be charged for parking. Please note there are no refunds for pre-paid parking if you arrive with four or more passengers.

Taxis, Uber, Drop off & Pickups enter from Princes Highway via Pettavel Rd through Gate A. **Taxis and Ubers will be in very short supply, we highly recommend not relying on being able to get one home.**

**NO DROP OFFS OR PICK UPS ON ROADWAYS**

Mini Buses enter via Pettavel Road, Gate D.

Accessible Parking, enter via Pettavel Rd, Gate E or Gate F.

Assistance buggy pickup / drop off

Parking for patrons in wheelchairs

Large buses enter from Reservoir Rd via Pettavel Rd through Gate D.

Concert & Dining parking passes enter via Gate E.

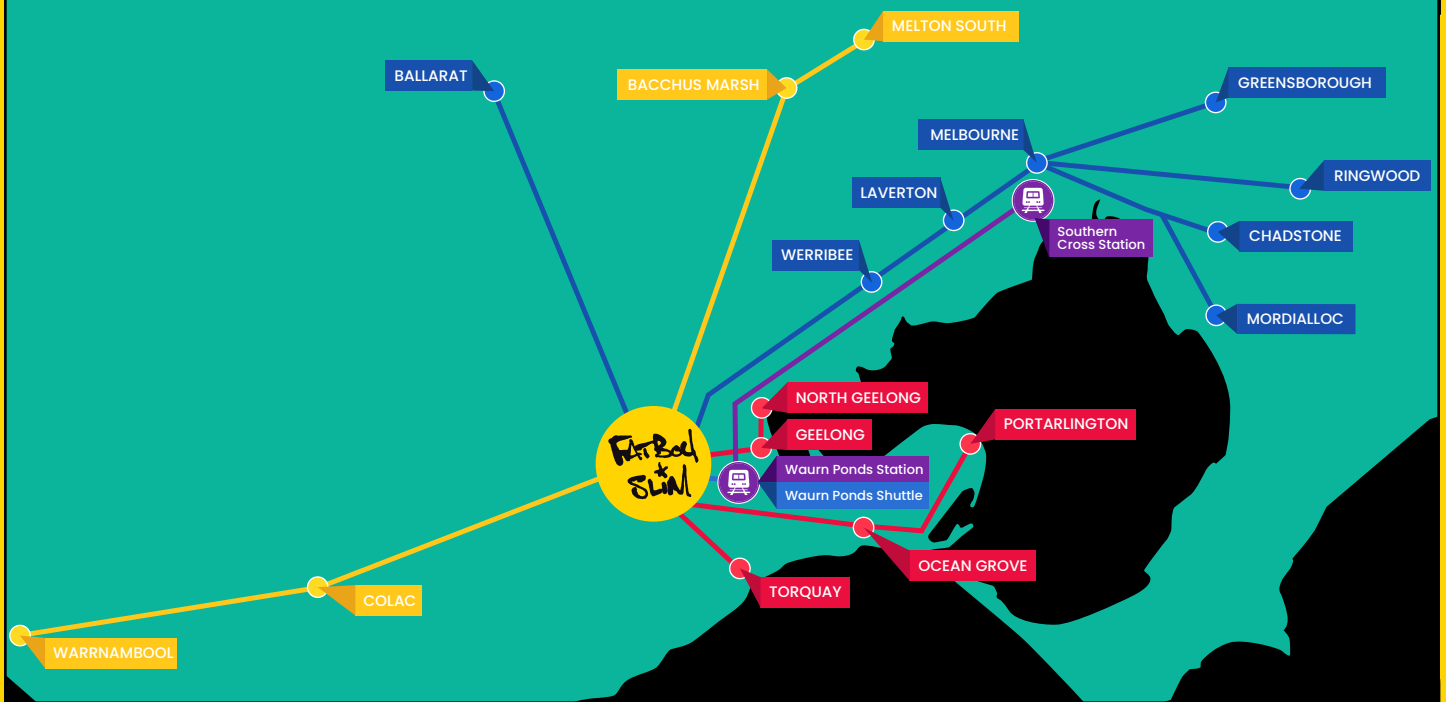

## ACCESSIBLE PARKING
